Note. On December 31, 1992, at midnight, the Czech and Slovak Federal Republic (CSFR, or Czechoslovakia) ceased to exist and was succeeded by two separate and independent states, the Czech Republic and the Slovak Republic. The United States formally recognized the Czech Republic and the Slovak Republic as independent states on January 1, 1993, and full diplomatic relations between these states and the US were immediately established.

Note. The United States view is that the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia has dissolved and that none of the successor states represents its continuation. The United States Government formally recognized Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, and Slovenia as independent states. Macedonia has proclaimed independent statehood, but has not been formally recognized as a state by the United States. Serbia and Montenegro have asserted the formation of a joint independent state, but this entity has not been formally recognized as a state by the United States.


